AP Capstone Program Grade 10 Seminar (ENG2DY2 Full Year)

- are increasingly valued by universities.
- (gr. 11)
- components is necessary for students to develop the skills to be successful in AP Research.
- In AP Seminar, students are assessed with two through-course performance tasks and one score (using the 1–5 scale) for AP Seminar.
- Presentation and Oral Defense; there is no exam in this course.

• AP Capstone is an innovative program from the U.S.College Board that uses an inquiry framework to equip students with the independent research, collaborative teamwork, and communication skills that

• AP Capstone is built on the foundation of two AP courses — AP Seminar (gr. 10) and AP Research

• AP Seminar is a prerequisite for AP Research; completing AP Seminar and all its required assessment end-of-course exam; all three assessments are summative and will be used to calculate a final AP

In AP Research the following year, students are assessed on a 4000-5000 word Academic Paper,

AP Capstone Program Grade 10 Seminar (ENG2DY2 Full Year)

- Interested students must select ENG2DY2 and HRE2O12 in myBlueprint
- The program will run for the full year where students will attend ENG2DY2 on day 1 and HRE2O12 on day 2
- Unfortunately AP/FI students can not participate in this program because of the HRE201Q requirement





Indicating Your Intention to Take a Summer School Acceleration Course


- Once you have finished selecting courses click on "REVIEW COURSE SELECTIONS".
