


Course Selection Procedures: How Many Courses Should I Select?

- Grade 11 students must select 6 to 8 courses and 2 alternates.
- Select at least 6 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 24 credits.
- Select at least 7 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 23 credits.
- Select 8 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 22 credits.


- Applied Degree (4 yrs.): 6 U or M Gr. 12 courses including ENG 4U





# Student Selection Criteria for COOP

- Be at least 15 years of age in Grade 11 • Earned at least 15 credits
- Complete an online Co-op Application Form (found in myBlueprint during course selection) • Secure and submit 2 teacher references
- Successfully complete an interview with a member of the Co-op Department
