Course Selection Procedures: How Many Courses Should I Select?

- Grade 11 students must select 6 to 8 courses and 2 alternates.
- Select at least 6 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 24 credits.
- Select at least 7 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 23 credits.
- Select 8 courses if at the end of Gr. 11 if you will have earned 22 credits.

- Compulsory courses failed in Semester 1 **MUST** be included on your course selection form.
- Changes will be made once courses have been successfully completed.



LEARNER PROFILE


- Benefits from hands-on learning

French Immersion

eLearning

- ****IMPORTANT**** All students must complete 2 eLearning courses to earn their OSSD unless they choose to opt-out or have been exempted
- Grade 11 students will be able to select from a wide range of eLearn options in myBlueprint
- a student may only take 1 elearn course per semester
- eLearn courses are entirely online and asynchronous and do not require students to be physically present in a classroom
- all elearn course codes end in an 8 as an identifier
- eg. CGW4U8 (World Issues), HFA4C8 (Nutrition and Health)

Student Selection Criteria for COOP

- Be at least 15 years of age in Grade 11
- Earned at least 15 credits
- Complete an online Co-op Application Form (found in myBlueprint during course selection)
- Secure and submit 2 teacher references
- Successfully complete an interview with a member of the Co-op Department

Benefits of Coop

- Explore tentative career choices
- Gain valuable work experience
- Strengthen essential and employment skills through on the job training
- Use equipment not available at school
- Make a smoother transition from school to work or post-secondary education
- Develop confidence and self-reliance
- Earn secondary school credits while gaining practical job experience
- Possibility of future employment with the company


